20th and N Streets Historic District

This is a small but distinctive neighborhood of simple working class cottages located between wealthier clusters of larger homes to the east and west. Perhaps it housed servants for those neighborhoods, as it was located near the same streetcar line. Most of the cottages were built in the 1880's and 1890's in variations of the simple high basement style with gable or hip roofs and very little ornamental detail. This District exhibits a rhythm in materials, texture, and setback.

This District is bounded by the railroad to the west, less cohesive residential areas to the north and south and by commercial spillover from 21st Street on the east.

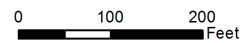
