CUP & BOP Update:

- CUP Applications = 162; 72 Approved; 3 Appealed
- BOP Applications = 138;
 - Approved = 1 Manufacturing
 - + 3 Approvals Pending



Delivery Registry

- Must have physical location in designated zones
- Co-location allowed
- Registry: CUP and BOP application submitted
- **Registry extended to March 31, 2018**
- Security-related questions being clarified with PD and BCC
 - (i.e. loading/unloading areas; shared/common areas)



Undue Concentration

Building Permits

- Delay in applying for Building Permits = Delay in Certificate of Occupancy = Delay in Business Operating Permit (BOP)

Sacramento Cracks Down on Illegal Grow Houses
As of Sept. 28, 2017, it's illegal to grow more than six plants inside a residential home. Cannabis must be grown indoors and must not generate an odor that can be detected outside the home or by neighbors.
