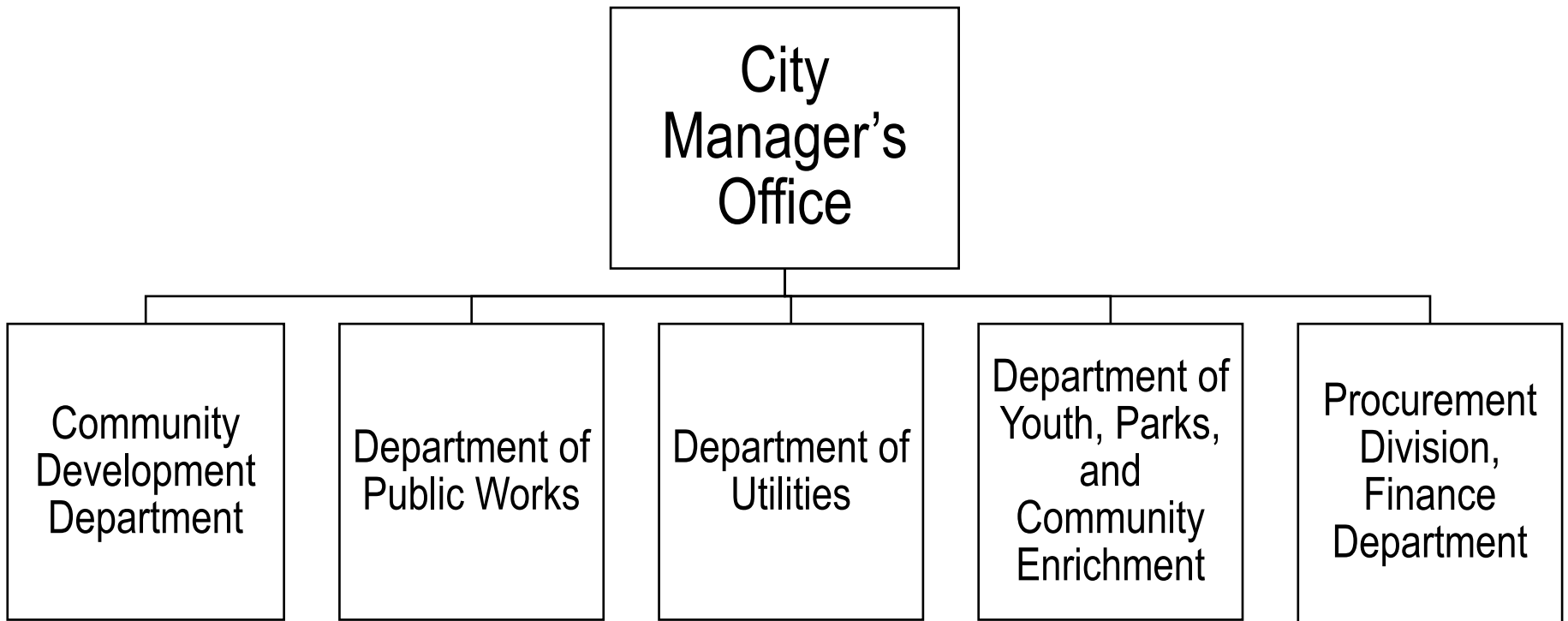

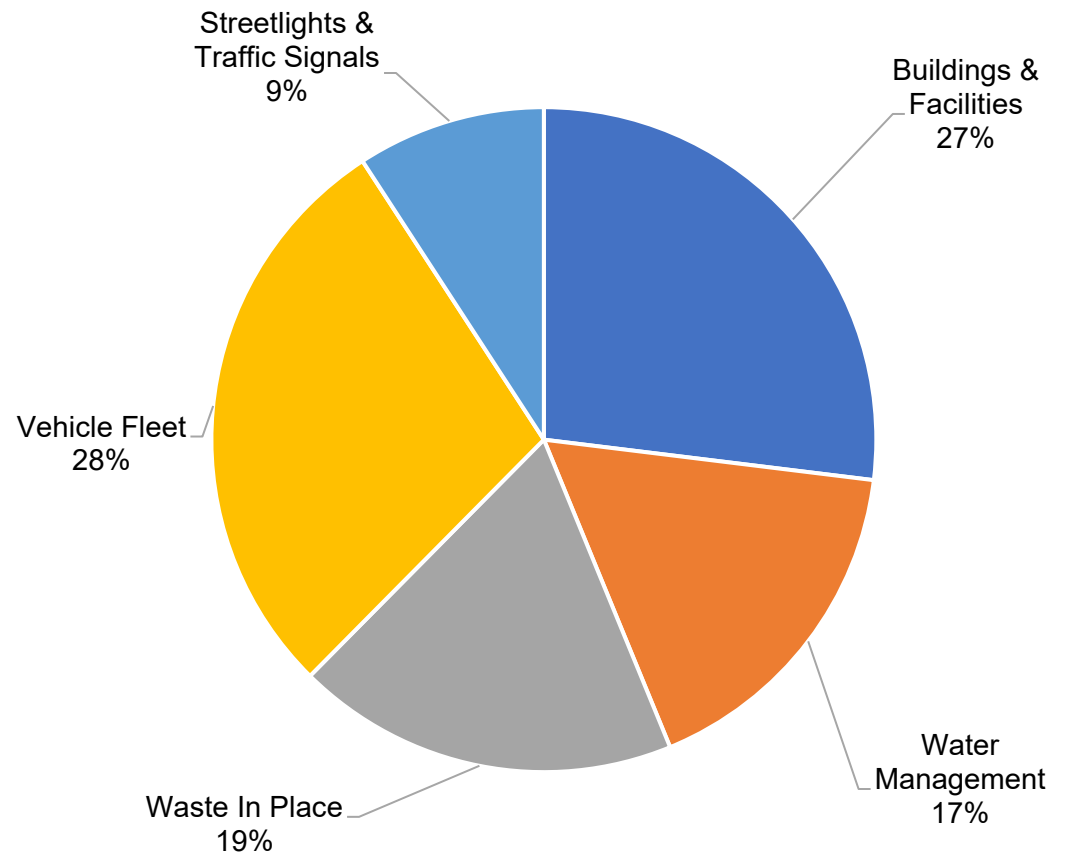

Exceeds 2020 goal of a 22% reduction

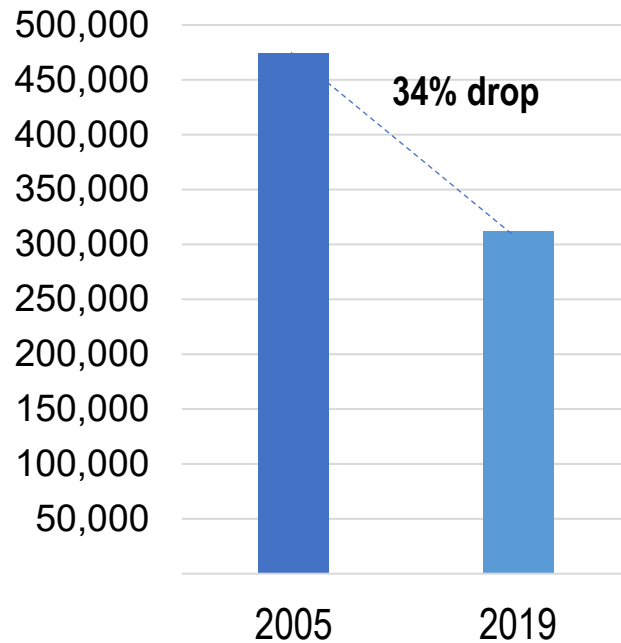
2016 Municipal GHG Emissions



56,463 metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent (MTCO₂e)

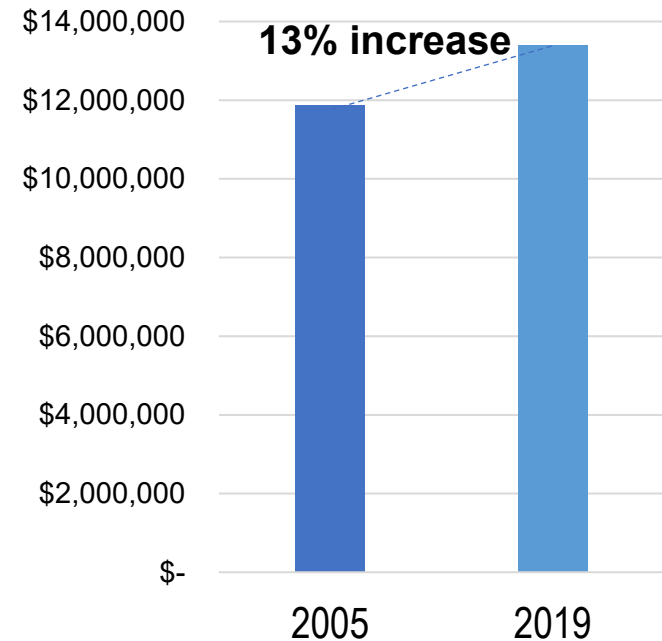
Municipal energy use and cost 2005-2019
