
**Notice to March, April and May 2020 Parties for Cannabis Administrative Appeal Hearings
re: COVID-19**

On March 17, 2020, the Sacramento Superior Court provided guidance on responding to the COVID-19 outbreak. Additionally, the federal, state and local governments require the implementation of social distancing and alternative operations to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Pursuant to the City of Sacramento Cannabis Administrative Penalty Appeal Hearing Rules of Procedure sections 1.02 and 2.03, the hearing examiners hereby postpone all administrative penalties appeal hearings (governed by Title 8 and Title 5 of the Sacramento City Code) until further notice.

On or about May 4, 2020, depending future developments regarding COVID-19, the hearing examiners' secretary will send notice to the parties of the revised hearing calendar and the date of hearing commencement.

NOTE: The postponement of administrative hearings does not translate to a reduction or elimination of the administrative penalty imposed. Appellants will not be required to pay towards the administrative penalty until the parties' have had an opportunity to be heard before the hearing examiner.
