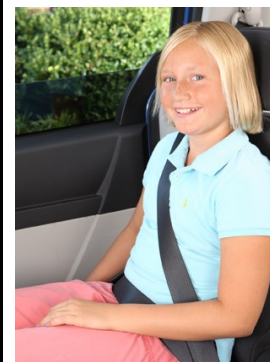
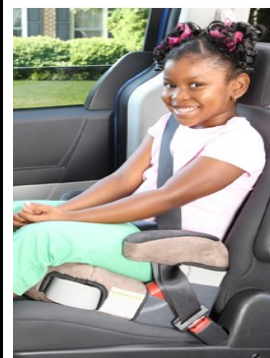

California Car Seat Law

Children under age 8 must be properly buckled into a car seat or booster in the back seat.

Children between age 8 and 16 must wear their seat belt correctly and should sit in a booster seat if necessary.

The seat belt fits properly if the shoulder belt lays across the collarbone and the lap belt is placed snugly at the hips.
