

Melted Beads

Materials needed:

- Muffin tin Pan (Doesn't matter what shape, Be creative!)
- Beads

Instructions:

1. Let your child arrange the beads in the tin can (*Let them create their own patterns*)
2. Try only doing one single layer, it's easier to melt and come out smooth.
3. If you can't drill a hole, just leave an open space within the beads (*TIP*)
4. once you're done with beads. Put the tin in the oven and melt the beads at 400 degrees for about 30 min
5. when done, Let the beads cool down. (*Tip: Freezer may cool faster!*)
6. Drill hole or if you already left the space open for your hole, your all done
