WHAT IS PRIME TIME TEEN?

The **Prime Time Teen Virtually Connected** program is an eight-week virtual workforce readiness and skill development program available for youth 13-17 years of age. The online program places an emphasis on engaging participants in the development of 21st Century workforce readiness skills and the creation of a small group community service project.

All instructional programming will be online via ZOOM and/or Google Classroom.

To receive the **monetary stipend**, a participant is required to attend, participate, and complete online instructional programming group sessions, community service project activities, and a mock interview. **During the program cycle, participants are allowed no more than two excused/unexcused absences.**

Hold Harmless Agreement for Participation in City of Sacramento Programs			
<p><u>Hold Harmless Agreement:</u> I understand that recreational activities are inherently dangerous and that serious accidents can occur. Knowing the risk and in consideration of my child being permitted to participate in City of Sacramento recreation programs, I agree to assume all risks of injury to my child. I agree to release and discharge in advance the City of Sacramento, its officers, employees and agents from any and all liability for personal injury, including death, to my child and for any damage to my child's personal property while under the care and custody of City staff, even though the liability may arise out of the negligence or carelessness of City staff. This release shall remain in effect until revoked in writing. I also assume full responsibility for my child's behavior, agree to be liable for any injury or damage caused by my child, and agree to pay for all damages to persons or property caused by the willful or unintentional acts of my child. I understand that if my child's behavior interferes with the program, City staff will contact the parent/guardian any my child may be expelled from the program without recourse or refund.</p> <p><u>Consent to Photograph:</u> By my signature below, I agree to City staff taking photographs and filming my minor child while participating in the City of Sacramento's recreation programs for publicity and public information purposes, including posting pictures on the City's webpage. If I do not consent, I have advised the City's program leader in writing of my refusal to permit my child to be photographed or filmed.</p> <p><u>Permission for Medical Treatment:</u> In case of an accident any my child suffers and injury which requires immediate medical treatment, I authorize City staff to call the 911 emergency number and I give my consent to any medical treatment and hospitalization as deemed necessary by an attending paramedic, nurse or physician. I further understand and agree that I will be responsible at my expense for all costs for responders, ambulance services, medical treatment and hospitalization as deemed necessary to respond to the medical emergency for the health and safety of my child.</p>
