Course Title: Training Orientation Program for Supervisors (8 hours/Virtual)

Course Description: This course is offered annually to newly promoted lieutenants and sergeants, as well as senior police officers aspiring to promote within the department. This training consists of handouts, videos, presentations, and reference documents for review by the participants. Additionally, all participants are mandated to ride along with a tenured patrol sergeant for 40 hours for additional perspective/experience and hands-on training.

Course Objectives: Upon completion of this course, the student will have reviewed, discussed and/or considered supervisory issues related to:

- Uses of Force & Civil Liability
- Critical Incidents (OIS), Special Investigations, Major Operations & Command Posts
- Vehicle Pursuits, Collisions, Fatalities & DUIs
- Employee Services Unit & Peer Support
- Leave, On-Duty Injuries/Exposure, Worker's Compensation
- Internal Affairs/Professional Standards, Complaints, Evaluations & Grievances
- Infection Control/Narcan, Technology, CAU, Training & Communications Updates

Course Assessment/Evaluation:

- Interactive discussion with Executive & Command Staff
- Class participation in table-top scenario discussions
- Mandated 40-hour ride-along with tenured patrol sergeant
