

On 09-16-2018, at approximately 0105 hours, I, Officer Menley #945 (1A47) was working vehicle patrol in the city of Sacramento, driving a fully marked Sacramento police car, and wearing a full police uniform. I was dispatched to [REDACTED] Arnold Ct. regarding a call of a domestic violence incident. Officer Singh #707 and myself arrived on scene at approximately 0109 hours. I observed the following in summary:

Per the initial call a male was fighting a female in front of the location (anonymous caller called from [REDACTED] Arnold Ct). While en route to the call dispatch received an update at approximately 0105 hours stating the male suspect was a male black, heavy build, black shirt, brown pants. Male was at that time walking into the court (Arnold Ct). The complainant was trying to see the female half.

A duplicate call came in (18-296055) stating the male and female were in a fight. The complainant's nephew was in a fight with his girlfriend. The girlfriend was leaving in an orange vehicle. The complainant hung up on the call taker.

The complainant on the original call gave an update prior to police arrival that the male and female were in a fight again. The female was hispanic or white, with long hair, wearing a black top, and jeans.

Dispatch attached a remark to the call at 0108 hours, prior to police arrival, advising that a loud argument was heard in the background, possibly over the female cheating.

I initiated my body worn camera and in car camera prior to arrival on scene. Officer Singh initiated his body worn camera upon arrival to the scene.

I made a northbound turn onto 23rd Street and observed a heavy set male black, wearing a black t-shirt and brown pants, that matched the description on the call. The male was later positively identified via physical descriptors as [REDACTED].

The male was walking eastbound across 23rd Street towards Arnold Ct. The male was taking large strides and moving at a fast paced walk, his chest



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was puffed out, his arms slightly back and both of his hands balled up in a fist. He was walking with his upper body leaning forward and was walking in a direct line towards the female half that was standing on the north side of Arnold Ct. The male was making direct and unbroken eye contact with the female half. Based on his body posture he appeared to be visibly angry. I did not observe any obvious visible injuries on the male half prior to police contact, during the approximately 15 seconds that I viewed him prior to his confrontation with police.

Based on multiple calls regarding this male subject and the female subject, and the male's body posture I believed that he was planning on physically assaulting the female. She was approximately 35 feet away from the male when I observed him walking towards her. The male was rapidly able to close the distance between himself and the female in a manner of 5 seconds.

Upon observing the male in the street I gave him a command to come to me. He ignored my command and continued walking towards the female at a fast paced walk. I again ordered him to come to me, and he again ignored my command and continued walking towards the female half in an aggressive manner. All of the commands that were given, were done so in a loud and authoritative tone to ensure they were heard.

As he approached the female he stated, "fuck you" in an aggressive tone.

I deployed my Conducted Electricity Device (CED), turned it on and pointed the red laser sight at the subject who was standing on the sidewalk in front of [REDACTED] Arnold Ct. I advised him to stop or he would be "tazed". The word tazed being a colloquialism for using the CED.

The male subject said, "I ain't scared of you, and "what you going to do" and approached me. The CED was still in my hand and outstretched towards him. With my free right hand I pushed the male subject on his chest area, pushing him back approximately 3 feet. He continued to approach me and reached out with his hand and forcibly removed the CED from my left hand, by making a fast slapping motion while stating, "get the fuck out my face". The CED landed in the middle of Arnold Ct but did not deploy.

As suspect [REDACTED] removed the CED from my hand, my chest mounted body worn camera fell onto the ground. My body worn camera remained on the sidewalk on the south side of Arnold Court for the remainder of the altercation, until S-[REDACTED] was taken into custody. The body worn camera did not capture additional video of the incident, but was still operable and captured portions of the audio.



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I ordered S- [REDACTED] to sit on the ground multiple times. He did not comply with my commands. At this point S- [REDACTED] had become verbally non-compliant as well as physically non-compliant with my multiple lawful commands.

Officer Singh and myself attempted to detain S- [REDACTED] by using departmentally approved handcuffing techniques based on his close proximity to both Officer Singh and myself, and based on the fact that S- [REDACTED] appeared to be unarmed. Officer Singh got a hold of one of S- [REDACTED] arms and I got ahold of the other arm.

S- [REDACTED] became actively physically resistive when he pulled his arms away from both myself and Officer Singh. He moved in quick, jerking motions in an effort to escape detention.

During this time I heard the complainant, S- [REDACTED] Aunt [REDACTED], yelling for S- [REDACTED] to get on the ground and to stop. She repeatedly told S- [REDACTED] to get on the ground and to stop fighting with police. S- [REDACTED] did not get on the ground and did not stop fighting with myself and Officer Singh. Dispatch heard and noted on the call the complainant telling S- [REDACTED] to get on the ground, and that she was yelling, "taze him".

S- [REDACTED] moved backwards towards the front of his Aunt's address ([REDACTED] Arnold Ct) while myself and Officer Singh attempted to get S- [REDACTED] into custody. S- [REDACTED] continued to actively resist detention. I again commanded him to get on the ground multiple times. He refused to comply.

Officer Singh was knocked down during the struggle. As a result, S- [REDACTED] was able to free both of his arms at which point I observed him turn towards Officer Singh who was seated on the ground (see Officer Singh's supplemental report for further details on his injuries sustained and actions taken).

I quickly broadcast my unit identifier and that I was fighting with one subject.

At that point S- [REDACTED] had both of his arms freed, and Officer Singh was on the ground. S- [REDACTED] made no attempt to flee the area to escape detention. During the short time that Officers did not have physical control of S- [REDACTED] he chose to turn towards Officer Singh to continue the physical altercation, resulting in physical injuries to myself, Officer Singh and S- [REDACTED]

Officer Singh was able to regain his footing, at which point he and I attempted to gain physical control of S- [REDACTED] During the continued



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struggle to gain control of S- [REDACTED] he struck me in the face region a minimum of one time. S- [REDACTED] intentionally struck me with a hard boney portion of his arm, either his fist or elbow. The portion of his arm used felt very dense, hard and like it was concentrated in a small area (consistent with an elbow or someone's knuckles).

Due to being struck one time in the upper brow area, I fell onto my back, on the front lawn.

I observed S- [REDACTED] mount me, with his face facing mine. He sat with his knees around my hips and the weight of his body pressed against my upper torso. Based on S- [REDACTED] decision to mount me, and place his full body weight against me instead of attempting to flee, I believed that S- [REDACTED] planned to continue to assault me.

Based on my training and experience I knew that S- [REDACTED] was in a position of advantage. Based on his multiple declined opportunities to comply with lawful commands, give up, or flee, I believed that S- [REDACTED] intended to cause myself great bodily injury using continued pugilistic hand strikes.

I used a free arm to reach up and pull S- [REDACTED] head down towards my lower chest, by applying downward pressure to the back of his neck. I simultaneously, attempted to use my hips to maneuver upwards, to get out from underneath S- [REDACTED] My plan was to isolate his head and neck towards my lower chest to limit his ability to strike me in the facial region with his hands and elbows, and give myself time to escape.

While attempting to control his movements, I heard the sound of what I believed to be Officer Singh's CED being deployed (see Officer Singh's supplemental for further information regarding the deployment of his CED and the effects on S- [REDACTED])

Once the CED was no longer being deployed I was able to remove S- [REDACTED] from the position of advantage. I placed S- [REDACTED] on his back and mounted him face to face. I attempted to gain control of S- [REDACTED] left arm, and Officer Singh attempted to gain control of his right arm. I updated over the radio that we were still trying to detain S- [REDACTED] that a CED was deployed, and that we needed the fire department to respond to the scene Code 3.

S- [REDACTED] continued to actively resist by attempting to assault me. He was still swinging his arm upwards towards my face in an effort to strike me with a pugilistic hand strike. I attempted to roll S- [REDACTED] onto his back to place him in handcuffs with negative results, due to his continued



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attempt to strike me using his hand.

Officer Singh and myself continued to struggle to detain S- [REDACTED] Based on S- [REDACTED] continued active resistance, his previous physical assault on myself and the female half, his multiple opportunities to flee and not fight with police, and the prolonged struggle, I continued to believe that S- [REDACTED] posed a great danger to myself, to Officer Singh and to the female half standing nearby.

Based on all of the facts and circumstances presented at the time of the event I believed that using pugilistic hand strikes to gain compliance was the safest and most viable option as my CED was now unaccessible, and seeing that using control holds was ineffective due to S- [REDACTED] rapid movement and continued attempted assault.

I attempted to strike S- [REDACTED] one time on his face using a pugilistic hand strike. He was able to move his head in time and I struck the concrete below him.

I then was able to successfully strike S- [REDACTED] one time on the left side of his face using a pugilistic hand strike to gain compliance from S- [REDACTED]

After delivering the hand strike, S- [REDACTED] stopped swinging his hands and arms at myself and Officer Singh. I observed that S- [REDACTED] became to shake his legs and head upper body back and forth. We were able to place S- [REDACTED] on his stomach and successfully handcuff him without further struggle.

Based on my training and experience I believed he was having a seizure. I advised over the radio that S- [REDACTED] was having a seizure. I again requested Code 3 fire to the location. I sat S- [REDACTED] into the recovery position and checked his vital signs. He was breathing and had a pulse.

The female half repeatedly approached S- [REDACTED] as he appeared to be seizing. She was advised that fire was en route code 3 and that she needed to back away.

Additional Sac PD units arrived on scene to assist with various assignments.

I requested Officer Singh put his CED away and collect mine that had been left in the middle of the street during the altercation. He collected my CED from its resting place and put it in his locked patrol car.



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Officer Hills arrived and took custody and care of S- [REDACTED] and awaited the fire department.

While awaiting fire arrival and standing near S- [REDACTED] he asked if I was the one he "got to wrestling with", I stated that I was. He looked at me and replied, "I'm sorry, I fucked up".

I retrieved my body worn camera from the sidewalk.

Engine 5 and Medic 12 arrived on scene. S- [REDACTED] was transported by fire Medic 12 to [REDACTED]. Officer Hills rode in the ambulance with the medic unit (see Officer Hills supplemental report for his observations, the suspect statement and any additional injury updates).

The female half, later positively identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] declined medical aide. Officer Singh provided her with a DV pamphlet, marsys's card, and information card with report number.

Officer Smalling contacted subject [REDACTED] regarding the fight with police as well as the initial domestic violence calls (see his supplemental report for further information).

I observed that S- [REDACTED] had an approximately 2 inch round swollen area underneath her left eye.

Officer Smalling, Officer Novak, and Officer Kellerman assisted with a neighborhood canvass (see their individual reports for further information).

Officer Smalling contacted subject [REDACTED] who was the original complainant (see his supplemental statement).

Officer Hills advised me that S- [REDACTED] advised that S- [REDACTED] had physically assaulted him prior to police arrival and that his injuries on his face were caused by her. Officer Kellerman advised that a neighbor witness confirmed that information. Based on statements taken by Officer Kellerman and Officer Hills the decision was made to charge the S- [REDACTED] with domestic violence.

She was taken into custody while still on scene without incident. Officer Smalling transported suspect [REDACTED] to the Sacramento County Main Jail without incident and booked her for misdemeanor domestic violence (243(e)(1) PC).



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I observed the I had sustained 3 approximately 1 inch round lacerations to the knuckle of my pointer finger, knuckle of my middle finger, and knuckle of my pinky finger on my right hand, related to the pugilistic hand strike used against S- [REDACTED] I later observed using a mirror that I had sustained an approximately 1 inch by 1 inch contusion that was red in color on my upper brow in between my eyes. The contusion was located in the same area that S- [REDACTED] had struck me during the altercation.

CSI was requested to the scene to document Officer injuries as well as to [REDACTED] to document injuries sustained by S- [REDACTED]

CSI arrived on scene and captured photographs of the injuries to myself, Officer Singh and also captured photographs of the scene.

I retrieved my CED cartridge from the middle of the roadway. Upon inspection, I observed that the doors on the cartridge had broken off and one of the probes was protruding. The wiring was still tightly coiled and appeared to have not been deployed. Officer Singh later booked the CED cartridge at JERPF as evidence, along with his deployed CED and AFID numbers.

S- [REDACTED] was later deemed fit for incarceration and booked at the Sacramento County Main Jail for assaulting a peace officer (69 PC) and felony domestic violence (273.5 PC) (see Officer Hill's supplemental report for further details).

We were parked right here on the corner in front of [REDACTED] 20th Ave. We were talking and I was getting ready to get out of the car and go in when we heard loud arguing outside. When I looked up I saw the man and woman arguing in front of that house ([REDACTED] Arnold Ct.).

The male was yelling at her saying something about her cheating. Then the male started walking away (southbound 23rd St.) from her. I thought he was maybe walking towards a car because she was telling him to get out of here. Then the female ran down the street after him and started wailing on him, slapping him and hitting him. She definitely was striking him. It looked like he turned around and shoved her and then she came back again after him. The man crossed the street and started walking back this way (northbound 23rd St.) and she hit him again but this time she knocked him down. He fell face down in the street. He go up and was trying to grab her arms because she kept hitting him. He eventually walked back up the street past our car and she walked back over to the house near the garage.

At one point he walked back down the street right next to our car (southbound). They were still yelling at each other. She was definitely the aggressor because she went running after this guy. The Asian cop got flung around like a wet blanket. I don't know what it was but the man was not cooperative. I saw him whipping his arms back but did not see him actually throw a punch. After they Tased him I could not really see based on where I was sitting. He was below my point of vision. I could not hear the Officers, I could just hear her screaming.

I saw one of the Officers try to pull him and they all fell in the grass. The man fell on top of the cop. I don't recall if that was before or after they Tased him. At that point they were trying to get the girl away because she was all of a sudden concerned for him.

The male was pretty beefy with a muscular build. He had on Khaki pants and a darker t-shirt. He was a big dude, he was not skinny. He was a male black adult with not a long nor short style hair cut, just grown out curl.

Your guys showed a lot of restraint with that big dude. He was really enraged and I think he may have been drinking but he did not appear to be like he was on something like drugs.

The bigger Officer was able to get him in a twist lock or something and twist him down onto the ground. Then the man was able to stand back up and he then hit the big Officer in the face. I don't know if it was an elbow or an upper cut but the big Officer fell down and the man fell on top of him. The little Officer got his Taser out. He used the Taser on the man and I could hear the "click click click click click" but it seemed like it did nothing. Then the man sat up and ripped it out of his chest.

The big Officer should be commended for what he did after he got hit in the face. It could have gone another way and I know if it was me it would have been different. This guy was not giving up. I would have had to really rely on my training, I use to be a security Officer at Grant High School.

I heard the Officers giving him commands, nice commands telling him to calm down. Once they started tussling they were telling him to get on the ground get on the ground. It was hard to hear everything because the lady was screaming so loud. When they first told him to calm down they did so 6 times at least, and all he said back was that he wasn't scared of them.

I think you could say that the Officers followed everything that they should have done and that the man should have stopped. You could tell that the man was pissed off and that he was trying to test the will of the big Officer. You should tell those Officers good job for how they handled that, especially the big Officer because he could have easily lost it.

On 09/16/2018 at approx.0104 hours, I, Ofc. Singh #707 was dispatched to assist 1A47 (Ofc.Menley #945) at [REDACTED] Arnold Court regarding a domestic violence in progress. I was driving a marked Sacramento Police patrol vehicle and wearing fully marked Sacramento Police uniform.

My body worn camera was activated throughout the incident.

We arrived on scene at approx. 0109 hours.

Upon arriving on scene, I observed a male subject (later identified as [REDACTED]) walking towards a female subject (later identified as [REDACTED]).

I observed Ofc. Menley give verbal commands to S-[REDACTED] several times. (SEE OFC MENLEY OBSERVATIONS).

I also observed that Ofc. Menley had his Conducted Energy Device (CED) out in his hands.

I took out my CED with my right hand and displayed it towards S-[REDACTED] in



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an attempt to gain compliance. S- [REDACTED] proceeded to walk towards Ofc. Menley and knocked his CED out of his hands. The CED fell in the middle of the roadway of Arnold Court.

Due to the close distance, I holstered my CED and attempted to grab S- [REDACTED] right hand in an attempt for a modified rear wrist lock. S- [REDACTED] pulled his right hand away from my hold and faced towards me. At this moment, my body worn camera fell off onto the ground.

I also observed Ofc. Menley attempt to place a rear wrist lock on S- [REDACTED] left hand.

A physical struggle ensued between Officers and S- [REDACTED]

S- [REDACTED] proceeded to strike me towards my face with a closed fist 2 to 3 times causing me to fall over on the ground near the front yard of the residence.

Once I was on the ground, S- [REDACTED] mounted on top of me and proceeded to strike towards my face 2 to 3 times with a closed fist. With the help of Ofc. Menley, I was able to disengage from S- [REDACTED] and get back on my feet.

As I stood up and regained my balance, I observed S- [REDACTED] stand up and walk towards Ofc. Menley. S- [REDACTED] proceeded to strike Ofc. Menley (unknown how many times) causing him to fall on the ground.

As Ofc. Menley was on the ground, S- [REDACTED] got on top of him and took a mounted position.

Both Ofc. Menley and S- [REDACTED] were physically struggling on the ground with each other. During the struggle, Ofc. Menley was able to pull S- [REDACTED] towards him exposing S- [REDACTED] lower back.

I feared that S- [REDACTED] possessed the ability to carry out an serious injury on a officer or a citizen. Due to the fact, S- [REDACTED] continuously physically resisting and assaulting officers attempt to detain him and not responding to any verbal commands given by the officers. I also feared for the safety of the female subject [REDACTED], as she was standing approx. 5 feet away from where S- [REDACTED] had mounted Ofc. Menley.

I determined deploying my CED was necessary in order to stop S- [REDACTED] from causing further harm to the officers and female subject [REDACTED].

Prior to deploying my CED at S- [REDACTED] I verbally announced "taser, taser,



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taser".

Second later, I deployed my CED at S- [REDACTED] I observed the CED probes connect with the lower back of S- [REDACTED] through his exposed skin. The cycle lasted 5 seconds. After the 5 seconds, I observed that S- [REDACTED] was still attempting to fight back as Ofc. Menley was able to roll over and gain a position of advantage on his left side of the body.

I placed my CED on the ground and went to the right side of S- [REDACTED] body.

S- [REDACTED] continued to swing at the officers.

I struck S- [REDACTED] 1 to 2 times with pugilistic hand strikes to his face.

I observed that S- [REDACTED] stopped actively resisting, which presented opportunity for officers to get S- [REDACTED] detained in handcuffs.

Ofc. Menley and I were able to get S- [REDACTED] in handcuffs without further incident.

Ofc. Menley requested medical aid and the supervisor to the scene.

I recovered and holstered my CED. I also recovered Ofc. Menley's CED from the ground and placed it inside the driver side of my patrol vehicle.

1SM4 (Sgt. Park) responded to the scene.

On 9/16/18 at approximately 0125 hours, I was in the back of Medic 12. Medic 12 was transporting S- [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] because he had been tazed during the incident. I was wearing my body worn camera and had it recording. S- [REDACTED] was detained in handcuffs. I read S- [REDACTED] his Miranda advisement verbatim from my department issued Miranda card. (SPD-133) S- [REDACTED] acknowledged each advisement verbally indicating he understood. He stated the following to me in summary:

I'm from Chicago. I came out to Sacramento about 2 or 3 weeks ago. I invited my girlfriend out and she got here a couple days ago. We went out to watch a pay per view fight. I don't drink often. I haven't had a drink in 3 weeks. I did have (6) beers and (3) mixed drinks. My girlfriend had more then me.

We were fighting because I found out she's been texting her ex. I told her I was done. I've been staying with my aunt at [REDACTED] Arnold Ct. She wanted to come in and I told her she wasn't allowed to come in. I wanted nothing to do with her.

She started trying to push past me. I pushed her back 2 or 3 times. She

balled her right hand into a fist and punched me in the left side of my face. She hit me 3 times. My memory starts getting foggy but I remember she then punched me with an uppercut to my nose and I started bleeding from my nose. I never punched her. I don't hit girls.

I remember getting up and starting towards my girlfriend who was in front of my Aunts house at the time. I heard a male voice yelling at me but I was in a rage. It just sounded like background noise to me. I remember a flash like a spot light hit me. I was still walking towards my girlfriend and someone grabbed my right arm and I jerked my arm away. I then spun around, leading with my left arm. I don't remember anything after that. I didn't know the guys were cops.

I've had seizures before. Last time was around 2 years ago because I was having an anxiety attack.
