On March 8th, 2021, Complainant [REDACTED] called Internal Affairs in regard to her 15-year-old niece, [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] claims her niece has been snapchatting with an Officer Daniel Donahue who has been asking to be in a relationship with her and has offered to fly out to see her. [REDACTED] took photos of her niece's phone conversation with Officer Donahue which included Officer Donahue in an SPD uniform. [REDACTED] claims Officer Donahue is aware of [REDACTED]'s age and still maintains contact with her. Upon initial review by Internal Affairs, it appeared that there was inappropriate communication between Officer Donahue and the juvenile. Due to these circumstances, an independent criminal investigation was started by SPD Detectives.
