## SCPRC RECOMMENDATION

GO 410.06 (Military Equipment Reporting Considerations)

SPD language related to annual reporting is too vague and does not require demographic reporting.

Add specific language to require SPD to produce its annual report using comparative reporting and demographic reporting, including details related to:

- (1) Where its military equipment and munitions were used;
- (2) Who its military equipment and munitions was used against;
- (3) What context its military equipment and munitions were being used.

## SCPRC RECOMMENDATION RATIONALE

The City and SPD frequently mentions their desire for data-driven policies, but the current draft for GO 410.06 appears to be vague in its annual reporting requirements and does not require SPD to provide annual metrics for how it uses its military equipment compared with the US military, where it is used, or in what context.

We recommend adding specific language that requires comparative reporting to illustrate the difference in how the military used this equipment versus how SPD intends to use them against civilians in Sacramento. According to Lt. Greg Galliano, the current policy appears to require comparative reporting, but we think this language can be more explicit in stating its purpose for such reporting.

We also recommend adding specific language to require demographic reporting which would provide crucial data about where SPD uses its military equipment and munitions, who it is used against, and in what context it used so that the City, the commission, and public may determine whether SPD is using such equipment disproportionately against specific communities or in inappropriate contexts.

## SPD RESPONSE
