Open house set to discuss proposed bike lanes for Freeport Boulevard south of 21st Street

The City of Sacramento Department of Transportation will be hosting an open house for the public to learn more about a proposed plan to add bike lanes to Freeport Boulevard between 21st Street and Sutterville Road.

The bike lanes and associated improvements are being considered because the road is set to be resurfaced in 2013, opening the window for the project to be completed at the same time. Making streets more efficient and safe for all modes of travel is in keeping with the City's 2030 General Plan.
