On behalf of the Land Park Community Association (LPCA), I write to reaffirm our *support* for the Del Rio Trail, which would convert the Walnut Grove Branch Line of the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to a paved bike trail with an unpaved walking path designed and designated for pedestrian and recreational bicycle use.

In August 2015, the LPCA initially supported the project by unanimously adopting a resolution backing the proposal to convert that abandoned railroad right-of-way into a City-owned and operated trail. Then, on June 20, 2018, our current board voted to continue our support and encourage the progress of the Del Rio Trail project.

The LPCA is excited about the prospect of this recreational amenity coming to a 4.5 mile stretch along an abandoned railway corridor to provide more opportunities for walking and biking during recreational and commute trips within the Sacramento region. Please let us know if the LPCA can do anything to further assist in efforts to bring the Del Rio Trail to fruition.
