Dear Mr. Barron,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide a letter of support for the Del Rio Trail Project. We understand the Project will soon be submitting a grant application for construction funding. The Del Rio Trail is a Class 1 multi-use trail that extends 4.5 miles along an abandoned railway corridor. The Learning Tree Preschool abuts the southeast corner of the Project's intersection with Fruitridge Road.

The safety and experience of our students and their families is important to us. Vehicle traffic on Fruitridge Road, adjacent to our preschool, is very fast. We understand the design proposes a new traffic signal at the Del Rio Trail and Fruitridge. We expect the new signal will help slow down traffic on Fruitridge Road.

In addition, the Project will provide a far more usable off-street trail in our neighborhood. One of our student's families use the current rail corridor for walking to our preschool, but the connection is poor. The installation of a standard sidewalk on the south side of Fruitridge Road between the Trail and Gilgunn Way would improve the connection. We hope the Project will encourage student's families to walk or bike to school.
