

RESIDENTIAL PARKING UPDATE

ONLINE TEMPORARY GUEST PERMITS



Printable 24-hour Temporary permits will allow residents up to 10 guest permits per month. This program is in addition to the existing Visitor permit. Residents with a valid Vehicle and/or Visitor permit are eligible for the online permit program, which will be available on www.sacpark.org in mid-October.

Participation in the online permit program is optional. Permits issued online serve as a supplement to the existing Visitor permit. Temporary permits will continue to also be available in the Revenue Division or by mail. Forms are available on www.sacpark.org or in the Revenue office (New City Hall 915 I Street).

Parking Enforcement Accommodations will continue to be available for larger gatherings. Requests must be received up to 5 days in advance of a scheduled event by calling 916-264-5011 or emailing ParkingCSR@cityofsacramento.org. Requirements and more information are available at www.sacpark.org.

PARKING OPERATING HOURS (Residential Parking Permit Zones)

Effective September 1, 2016, parking operating hours for metered and non-metered spaces regulated by time limits in Central City Residential Parking Permit (RPP) zones will have a new end time of 10 p.m. These changes were approved by City Council on March 22, 2016. RPP streets are identified by posted signage reflecting the words, "Except with _ Permit".

Informational notices, as opposed to citations, will be issued to vehicles parked past 6 p.m., for up to 60 days, to apprise both residents and non-residents of the changes.



PARKING OPERATING HOURS (Non-residential)

Parking operating hours apply to both metered and non-metered spaces regulated by time limits.

- Sunday and holiday parking will continue to be exempt
- Check posted signs for days of enforcement on that street
- Tier-based SacPark meter program allows extended parking past the posted time. Learn more at www.sacpark.org under "Meters"
