



Construction ahead: Parking lot improvements

Parking Advisory: Wednesday, Nov. 12, 2014 – Friday, Feb. 13, 2015

Stage 1 of the two-year station renovation will start construction in the front parking lot of the depot as part of the series of projects to expand and improve the Sacramento Valley Station. (Current work on the West Parking lot will conclude and be open for parking Nov. 10.)

By Fall of 2016, we will create a better flow for vehicles and pedestrians between the station and Old Sacramento that will have:

- A direct, accessible pedestrian route to the station front (completed by Feb. 13, 2015)
- Six additional tour bus stalls
- Improved ADA access and vehicle flow
- New and improved lighting
- 13 EV parking spaces
- New and additional pay stations
- 160 bike stalls, including e-lockers, and rentable commuting bikes
- Improved way-finding signage
- New modern ticketing and baggage services
- New plaza and walkways
- 25,000 square feet of leasable space for retail and office uses

What to expect during construction

Parking – allow extra time

During construction, half of the available parking on the west side of the front lot will be closed.

Daily parkers

Park at the Old Sacramento Garage at 2nd and I Streets or new West Parking lot. Please allow extra time to park. The Commuter Special rate of \$4 per day is available if you are in by 7:30 a.m. and out after 5:30 p.m. or in Lot 297 for \$10 per day.

Monthly parkers

Overflow is located in Lot 297, lot entrance located at 7th & G. Please display your hang tag to avoid a citation.

Holiday travel drop-offs of passengers

Please avoid driving into the front parking lot for drop off during the holidays. The safest, fastest drop-off of passengers is across the street just east of 4th and I streets, on the south side of I street. **See complete map on the back.**


