

PARKING PERMIT PILOT

EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION PARKING PERMIT PILOT

Installation of pilot permit signage for parking spaces bordering the property line of St. Francis High School is scheduled for the end of September 2018.

Presently, parking along this property line is unrestricted, resulting in occupancy of vehicles that prevent school staff from finding nearby spaces to their work. This causes staff to park in Residential Permit Parking (RPP) zones.

The pilot will establish new restrictions along the school-owned property line that will require an Educational Institution (EI) parking permit to park during specific days and hours. This will allow staff to park at the school and not in the RPP areas.

This pilot will assess whether these new restrictions will provide the balance needed to accommodate parking for school personnel without affecting the nearby RPP zones.

PILOT REGULATIONS

Enforcement hours for pilot spaces:

Monday - Friday
7 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Parking without EI permit is allowed:

Monday - Friday
4 p.m. - 7 a.m.

Saturday and Sunday
(at all times)

Duration of pilot:

September 2018 - June 2019

Signage Installation:

End of September 2018

Enforcement:

Prior to the start of enforcement, warnings (not citations) will be issued for two weeks after sign installation

PILOT PARKING SPACES

Pilot parking restrictions apply only to parking spaces bordering the school-owned property line on these streets (map on reverse):

M Street (north side) from east property line of 6001 M Street to Louis Way

Louis Way (west side) from M Street north to the south property line of 5900 Elvas Avenue

60th Street (west side) from M Street north to the north property line of 1290 60th Street

61st Street (east side) from M Street north to the north property line of 1291 61st Street.


