



March 29, 2013 is the Last Day Customers Can Switch Yard Waste Services

On July 1, 2013, yard waste collection services in the City of Sacramento will change. All residential Recycling & Solid Waste customers will receive weekly containerized yard waste service, as well as loose-in-the-street service from November thru January.

Currently 12,000 customers receive weekly loose-in-the-street service and 104,000 customers receive weekly containerized service. Until March 29, 2013, customers may switch from loose-in-the-street service to containerized, or from containerized to loose-in-the-street service. After March 29, 2013, customers may not change their yard waste service type.

The March 29 deadline is necessary so the City can prepare for the July 1 service changes to containerized yard waste service for all customers.
