Backyard composting allows you to recycle your yard clippings and fruit and vegetable scraps into a valuable soil amendment right in your own yard. It is a great way to save money, reduce the amount of waste that is disposed, and improve the quality of your soil. The Recycling & Solid Waste Division is hosting three free composting seminars this fall:

Saturdays: Two Sessions from 8:00-9:00AM and 9:00-10:00AM on the following dates:

- September 13, 2014 Sparrow Community Garden, 3219 Sparrow Dr. (North Natomas)
- October 4, 2014 Southside Community Garden, 5th and W Street (Downtown)
- November 1, 2014 Fremont Community Garden, 14th and Q Street (Mid Town)
