#### **Audio Connection issues:**

Since these hearing are established as a web conference, your microphone will be automatically muted upon arrival. In some cases, you will need to select audio source in order to speak once your hand has been raised and the director allows public testimony for the associated item. In order to select your audio connection (microphone) click on the bubble with <a href="mailto:three-dots">three dots</a> at bottom of page (this my be hidden, so just hover over the bottom for it to pop-up), and select <a href="mailto:Audio Connection">Audio Connection</a>.





Once <u>Audio Connection</u> has been selected, a selection box will open up with <u>three choices</u>, select the one that best suits your needs. We suggest using the "Call me" if you are having problems as WebEx will call you at the number you have provided.
