

## MASSAGE PRACTITIONER AND ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT INSTRUCTIONS

## MASSAGE PRACTITIONER

- 1. The City of Sacramento issues a Massage Practitioner Permit to people wishing to practice massage or body work.
- 2. Fee for a Massage Practitioner Permit
  - a. New \$200, Renewal \$175
    - i. A new applicant who is not certified by the California Massage Therapy Council must also submit to a Live Scan service and authorize access to information to the City of Sacramento. Forms and instructions are located on website at www.cityofsacramento.org/Business-Permits
  - b. Persons certified by the California Massage Therapy Council \$0 (whether new or renewal)
- 3. Massage Practitioner Permits are issued for two years. The next expiration date is February 28, 2024.
  - a. Renewal applications must be submitted 30 days prior to permit expiration.
- 4. Massage practitioner applicants must provide:
  - a. A completed Special Business Permit Application (MASS\_IND\_EST)
  - b. Property Owner Acknowledgment form (PO1) for each commercial location in which they will be providing services
  - c. A valid California driver's license or identification card (new only)
  - d. Two passport-sized photos (more photos may be requested, if needed)
  - e. Proof of Insurance
    - General liability insurance coverage in the minimum amount of one million dollars per occurrence.
  - f. Proof of education
    - New applicants must have at least 250 hours of massage education from a recognized school of massage



- ii. All applicants must have 12 hours continued education in the last 12 months
- g. Applicants operating as independent contractors (e.g., *not* an employee) must have a valid Sacramento Business Operations Tax Certificate, which can be obtained online at: cityofsacramento.org/BOT

## **MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENT**

- 1. If you operate a business and more than 10% of your business revenue is earned for massage services, you must obtain a Massage Establishment Permit.
- 2. The fees for a Massage Establishment Permit are:

•	\$150	Massage Establishment - Outcall Onl	ly
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- \$200 Massage Establishment One Massage Therapist
- \$375 Massage Establishment Two Massage Therapists
- \$550 Massage Establishment Three Massage Therapists
- \$700 Massage Establishment Four Massage Therapists
- Massage Establishment Excess of Four Massage Therapists

\$700 + \$175 for the fifth and each subsequent massage service provider

- 3. A **new** massage establishment applicant who does not hold a massage practitioner permit must submit to a Live Scan service and authorize access to information to the City of Sacramento . Forms and instructions are located on website at <a href="https://www.cityofsacramento.org/Business-Permits.">www.cityofsacramento.org/Business-Permits</a>.
- 4. Massage Establishment Permits are issued for two years and all expire at the same time. The next expiration date is February 28, 2024.
  - a. A renewal application is due 30 days prior to the date of expiration
- 5. Applicants must provide:
  - a. A completed Massage Establishment Permit Application (MASS\_IND\_EST)
  - b. Proof of ownership or leasing rights to the business location property address

- i. If the applicant is not the owner of the property, a Property Owner Acknowledgement Form (PO1) must be submitted with an application.
- c. Proof of insurance
  - i. General liability insurance coverage in the minimum amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence, and the policy must be endorsed to include all of the massage practitioner permit holders who operate in the establishment
- d. Personal Disclosure Forms of all business owners
- e. All businesses operating within the City of Sacramento must have a valid
  Business Operations Tax Certificate with the City, which can be obtained here:
