

About the East End Garage- In the heart of Midtown

How do I enter the East End garage?

The entrance is on 17th Street between L Street and Capitol.

Why should I park in the East End garage instead of on the street?

For a flat rate of only \$2, the East End garage provides ample parking, which eliminates spending time circling around to find an open space on the street. The location of the garage is also only a short walk away from all the major venues in the Handle District and Midtown Sacramento. Park in the East End garage and you won't have to worry about time or having enough change for a meter. The East End garage also provides a well-lit, covered facility, which keeps vehicles out of the rain or sun.



The flat rate on Second Saturdays is \$5.

The East End garage is an economical and easier alternative for those who work in the evenings or on the weekends in the surrounding area. It is also a convenient place to park and walk to all the area's great attractions!

How do I pay to park in the East End garage?

Upon entering, the parking fee will be collected from you by an attendant. Only cash or checks are accepted at this garage. A token coin will be given to you to allow you to later exit the garage.

What are the garage hours of operation?

The garage is open for public parking **after 4 p.m.** during the week (Monday – Friday). All vehicles parked in the garage for public parking must exit no later than 6 a.m. to allow for the garage's regular monthly customers to park during the day. Any vehicles still in the garage after 6 a.m. will be subject to tow at the vehicle owner's expense.

On Saturday and Sunday, the garage is open to the public all day beginning at 10 a.m. However, vehicles must exit the garage no later than 6 a.m. on Monday morning to avoid being towed.

Why is the garage only available to the public during specific times?

During the week day (Monday – Friday) the East End garage serves as a privately owned monthly parking facility which is not open to the public. In an effort to increase parking supply in the area, the City of Sacramento agreed to manage public parking in the garage during the evening and weekends. It is for this reason that any vehicles parked in the garage during "public parking" hours must exit prior to 6 a.m. to accommodate the parking program established in the garage.

How do vehicles exit the garage?

Upon exiting the garage, please drive up to the exit booth and deposit the token coin. The gate arm or roll cage will automatically rise. If are unable gain access to the garage to retrieve your vehicle, please press the intercom button located at the garage entrance and a security officer will assist you.
